## Graduate Certificate in Environmental Compliance

The Graduate Certificate is delivered by Flinders University School of Law in conjunction with TAFE SA and Fox Tucker Lawyers and is supported by the Australian Environmental Law Enforcement and Regulators Network (AELERT).

The program has been designed to equip interested individuals with a solid grounding in environmental law, particularly those involved in compliance and enforcement. This program is designed for environmental regulators and those seeking employment in environmental compliance. Participants will study four topics over one year on a part time basis – three online and one in intensive attendance mode:

- Principles of Environmental Law (online)
- Environmental Compliance: Theory and Practice (online)
- Investigating Environmental Crimes (intensive attendance over four days)
- Enforcing Environmental Law (online).

Minimum entry requirements for this Graduate Certificate:

- Relevant post secondary qualifications e.g. Certificate IV in Government (Compliance or Investigation) and/or
- Relevant vocational, scientific or management experience in environmental regulation, or
- Significant vocational experience in compliance and investigation.



(Minimum entry requirements apply to this course in terms of post secondary qualifications or relevant vocational experience.)
