- Students will need to have their own computer with software available at home. It is a responsibility of an individual student to organise computer and software to use at home. Educational software licenses will be available to all registered students.

- In addition to the hardware listed on Autodesk website you will need the following:
 - Two screens. If your computer has one screen only you may be able to connect HDMI enabled TV as a secondary screen.
 - Computer mouse – laptop touchpad is not good enough!
 - You will also need your own headphones with microphone for online sessions and for watching recordings in the classroom.
- **Software installed:**
 - Ms office or equivalent (e.g., Libre office, Open office etc.)
 - PDF viewer • File compression software (e.g., 7z)
 - Internet browsers (Edge, Firefox, Chrome)
 - Autodesk Inventor Professional 2023 – The software is available for download from Autodesk website. Please register with Autodesk using your TAFE email address to get student software license.
- **Important** – the only version accepted by TAFE in year 2023, is the 2023 version of Inventor Professional. Older or newer versions of Inventor software are not allowed, and any work done in a different version will not be accepted.
