

SAFETY FIRST

The Tonsley construction project is currently being developed by multiple construction and civil works contractors.

To ensure the safety of staff, students and visitors to TAFESA, Renewal SA has developed a Safety Management Plan for the introduction of TAFESA onto the construction site.

As the TAFESA location is adjacent to a construction site, it is important for staff, students and visitors to be mindful of this when moving around Tonsley.

The table within provides a summary of the safety measures that are relevant to staff and students. You are urged to familiarise yourself with the information in this Safety Sheet.

TAFE SAFETY SHEET

SAFETY MEASURES		WHAT STAFF AND STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO DO
1	Footpaths for pedestrians	Pedestrians must only walk on footpaths and cross the road at pedestrian crossings.
2	Parking	Staff and students are only to park in the car park.
3	Roadway	There are roadways only for commercial and construction vehicles. Cars are restricted to roadways accessing the car park only.
4	Entrance from South Road	There will be a dedicated Tonsley Loop Bus Service from the South Road entrance. Staff and students who access the premises from South Road must use this provided service.
5	Emergency Assembly Points	There are two emergency assembly points for TAFESA. See adjacent map.
6	Security Arrangements	All incidents, including injuries, must be reported to the security officers at the following number: 8276 5099
