Hair and Beauty



TAFE SA Hair and Beauty program can offer you vocational education and training (VET) for Schools as part of our nationally recognised training package and is available to students from years 10 to 12 as part of their normal school curriculum.

The Hair and Beauty VET for Schools program helps students:

- develop practical, industry-specific skills
- develop an understanding of the world of work
- gain a nationally recognised qualification.

VET study also counts towards the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) and is the perfect pathway into further hair and beauty study at TAFE SA, or it can prepare students for employment or gaining an apprenticeship or traineeship.

Our short courses provide you with a taste of the hair and beauty industry; they give you a good understanding of the scope and career options the industry can offer you.

Training Guarantee for SACE opportunities are available with select courses, contact a hair and beauty representative at your local campus.

Students can continue their studies onto Certificate II in either Hairdressing or Beauty including Make-up and Nail Technology.

SHORT COURSES

Directions in Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy SIH20111

An intro course to expose you to the hair and beauty industry. You'll have fun watching and participating in skin care, make-up, nails, blow-drying, braiding, long hair styling, basin services and salon skills. From this course you can decide to study further in hairdressing or beauty pathways. From here you would enrol into one of the Certificate II courses as below.

8-10 weeks, 1 day p/w, 10 SACE Credits \$595
(aimed at year 10 students)

The Make-up and Beauty Palette SIB20110

Provides you with a taste of the beauty industry with a focus on make-up artistry. From this course you will find it easy to decide whether beauty is the training pathway for you.

You will then move onto the Certificate II in Retail, Make-up and Skin Care as below.

8-10 weeks, 1 day p/w, 10 Stage 1 SACE Credits \$595
(aimed at year 10 students)

Style for Success SIB20110

You will touch on all things hair and beauty with a focus on personal hair and make-up tips and advice. This 5 week short course is available in Term 4 only.

5 weeks, 1 day p/w, 5 Stage 1 SACE Credits \$325
(aimed at years 10/11/12)

The short courses are all designed to give you a taste of the hair and beauty industry before committing to training in this career pathway. They can also be used as a taster to the Certificate II courses and will assist in meeting TGSS eligibility criteria. All provide valuable SACE Credits.

HAIRDRESSING

Certificate II in Hairdressing SIH20111

If you have decided hairdressing is the career for you, this is your training pathway. You can choose between hairdressing specific subjects or you can incorporate some skincare and make-up, making you even more employable. You will learn to salon assist to 'salon standards' in areas such as greeting and preparing clients, braiding, blow-drying, shampooing and basin services. You will also gain professional product and service knowledge, communication and salon practical skills. This certificate is the 1st qualification in your chosen career pathway and most of the subjects transfer to Certificate III in Hairdressing.

1 year, 1 day p/w, 50 Stage 1 SACE Credits \$1,576
(aimed at year 11 students)

Pathways to Certificate III in Hairdressing SIH30111

This will take you another step closer to your hairdressing apprenticeship. Certificate III in Hairdressing is a very expansive qualification with 32 subjects. With this course and the units that transfer from your Certificate II in Hairdressing you will be almost half way through your qualification. This is a bonus to employers as you will have already almost completed half of your off-the-job training once completing this course. During 'pathways' you will develop the skills to be able to provide service and advise to clients with all the fundamentals of styling, including long hair styling, thermal and creative styling. You will also develop your skills and knowledge in hairdressing science and treating hair and scalp conditions.

1 Semester, 1 day p/w, 25 Stage 2 SACE Credits \$1,190
(aimed at year 12 students)

BEAUTY

Certificate II in Retail Make-up and Skin Care SIB20111

If make-up or beauty services is your chosen pathway this course is your next step. You will be training in skin care, skin types, facials, products, day and evening make-up and make-up for photography with your very own professional 'photoshoot'. You will be able to work as a make-up assistant or at a department store giving advice and providing service on skincare and make-up.

1 year, 1 day p/w, 55 Stage 1 SACE Credits \$1,576
(aimed at year 11 students)

Certificate III in Beauty Services SIB30110

(after completion of Certificate II Retail, Make-up and Skincare)

Develop the skills to begin your career in the beauty services industry. You will develop your skills knowledge in customer advise and service, providing camouflage make up and/or nail technology, waxing, lash and brow treatments, manicure and pedicure treatments, skin biology, along with demonstrating and advising on services and retail skincare. This is a fantastic opportunity to leave school with an ATAR and a Certificate III level qualification.

2 x Semester, 1 day p/w, 35 Stage 2 SACE Credits \$1,190 per semester
(aimed at year 12 students)
