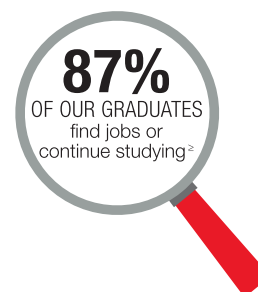

English Requirements

The minimum IELTS (or equivalent) score for entry to most TAFE SA courses is an academic IELTS of 5.5 with a minimum of 5.0 in all bands.

Some courses including the associate degrees, dental and oral health, hospitality, landscape design and nursing have higher IELTS requirements.

Academic Entry Requirements

Each individual course at TAFE SA has academic entry criteria that students must meet to be eligible for enrolment in that course. To check the specific academic entry requirements for your chosen course, visit the course page on the website tafesa.edu.au/international/international-courses. In general, the minimum academic entry is:

Certificate III course – satisfactory completion of Year 10 or equivalent

Certificate IV course – satisfactory completion of Year 11 or equivalent

Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Associate Degree and Bachelor courses – satisfactory completion of Year 12 or equivalent

Country	Equivalent to Australian Year 10 or 11	Equivalent to Australian Year 12
Malaysia	SPM (2 passes) or GCE O-Levels (4 passes) or Senior Middle 2	STPM Senior Secondary Certificate of Education (2 passes) or GCE A Levels – 2 passes, UEC successful completion

Designed for students with good English language skills who are planning to do further study at TAFE SA or university.

English for Academic Purposes Advanced (086001K)

Aimed at students needing advanced English language skills for university study at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

Advanced IELTS Preparation (074846G)

An intensive course aimed at improving your IELTS test score for further study, work, immigration or professional registration.
