START YOUR JOURNEY TO YOUR CAREER

The training is initiated by your employer or GTO through the Australia Apprenticeship Support Services provider (AASS).

This process involves a contract that is mutually agreed upon by the employer and the apprentice or trainee. It includes:

- > Duration of the apprenticeship/traineeship
- > Training and employment arrangements
- TAFE SA details, as the preferred nominated training provider.

TAFE SA TRAINING PLAN DEVELOPMENT AND FEES

- > TAFE SA will help you and your employer develop your training plan.
- > TAFE SA will enquire with your employer about covering your tuition fees. If your employer is not covering these costs, you will receive an invoice from us upon enrolment.

ROLES OF EMPLOYERS, AUSTRALIA APPRENTICESHIP SUPPORT SERVICES (AASS) AND TAFE SA

EMPLOYERS

Provide on-the-job training, support, and supervision to apprentices/trainees, sign training contracts, and may assist with training fees.

AUSTRALIA APPRENTICESHIP SUPPORT SERVICES (AASS)

Provides information, guidance, and support to employers and apprentices/trainees.

AASS facilitates registration and management of training contracts, administers financial incentives, and coordinates stakeholders for effective apprenticeship support.

TAFE SA

Offers vocational training programs, supports apprentices/trainees throughout their training, administers training plans, and ensures quality training delivery. Provides access to specialised facilities, resources, and experienced trainers that facilitate learning.

GROUP TRAINING ORGANISATIONS
