

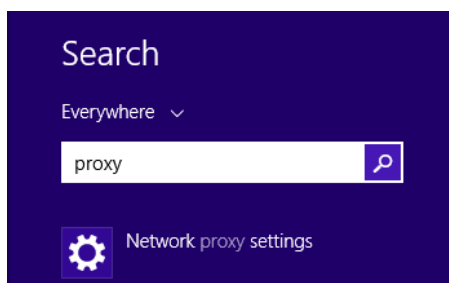

Setting a proxy on a Windows 8.1 Laptop

1. Ensure you are connected to the TAFESA-Internet wireless network.
2. Click or press the 'Windows' button in the bottom-left corner of the screen, then type 'proxy' and select 'Network proxy settings' as shown below.



3. Slide the bar to turn On Use a proxy server. In the Address field, type the word 'proxy' and in the Port field type '8080'. Then click the 'Save' button.

Manual proxy setup

Use a proxy server for Ethernet or Wi-Fi connections. These settings don't apply to VPN connections.
