

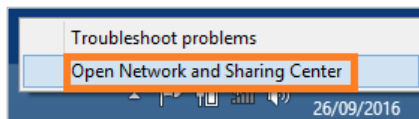
# How to Guide

## Connect to TAFE SA Wi-Fi Windows 7/8 Laptop

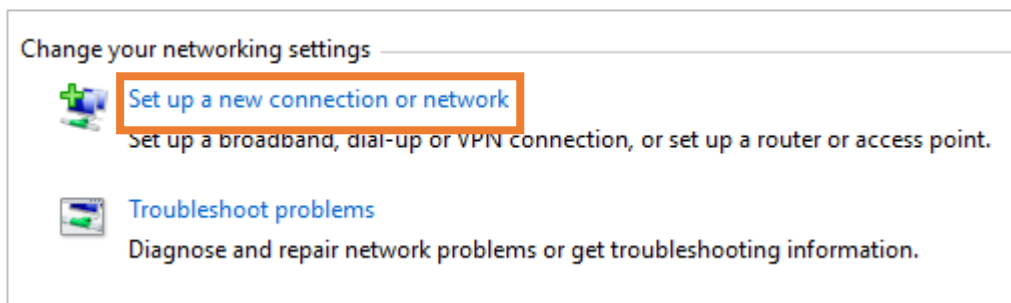

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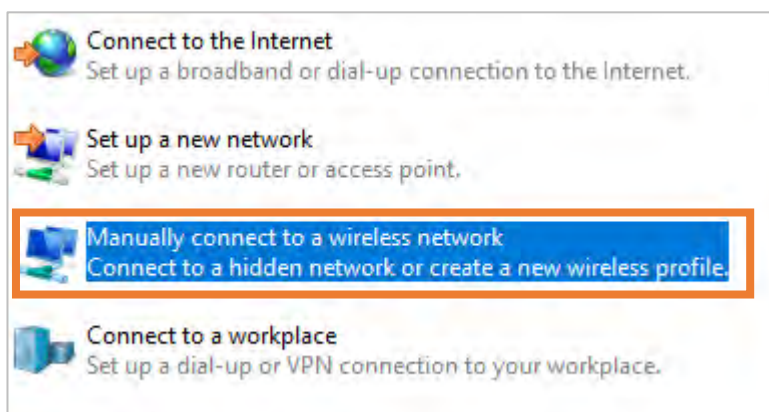
1. Log in to your laptop and ensure you are in range of TAFE SA Wi-Fi (for example, in the campus library or common student area).
2. Right-click on the network icon in the taskbar (bottom-right corner) and select **Open Network and Sharing Center**.



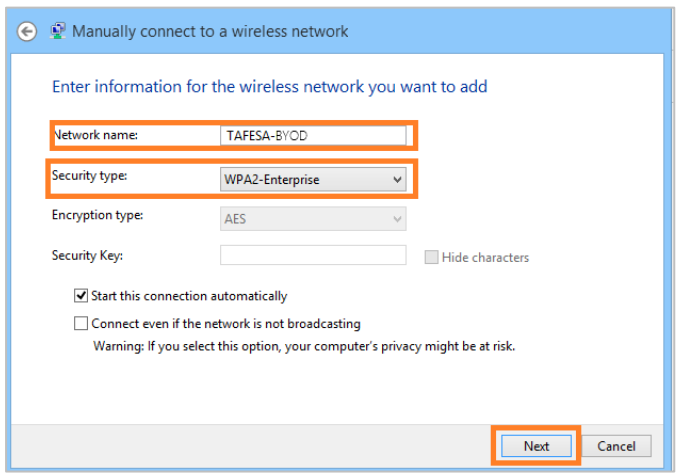
3. Select **Set up a new connection or network**.



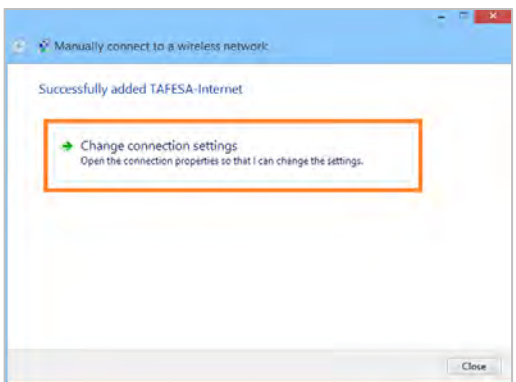
4. Select **Manually connect to a wireless network** and click **Next**.



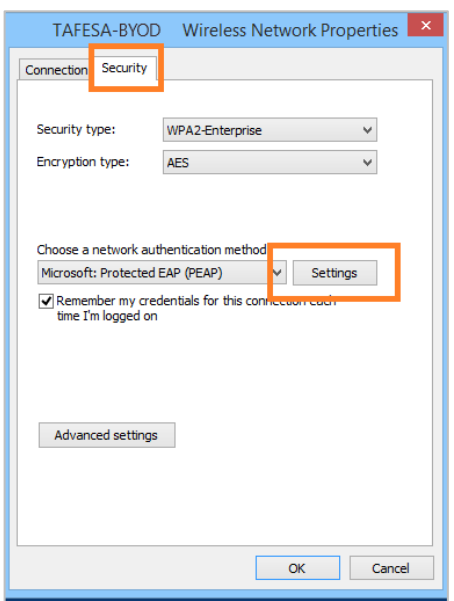
5. Type the details as shown below and click **Next**.
- a) Network Name – TAFESA-BYOD
  - b) Security Type – WPA2-Enterprise
  - c) Encryption type – AES



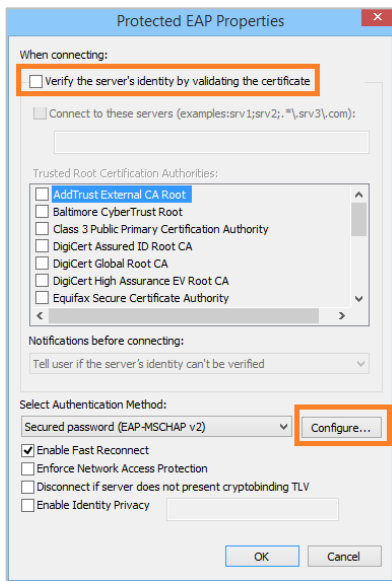
6. Select **Change connection settings**.



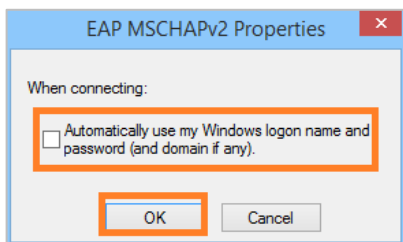
7. In the next window, select the **Security** tab and click the **Settings** button, next to the **Choose a network authentication method**.



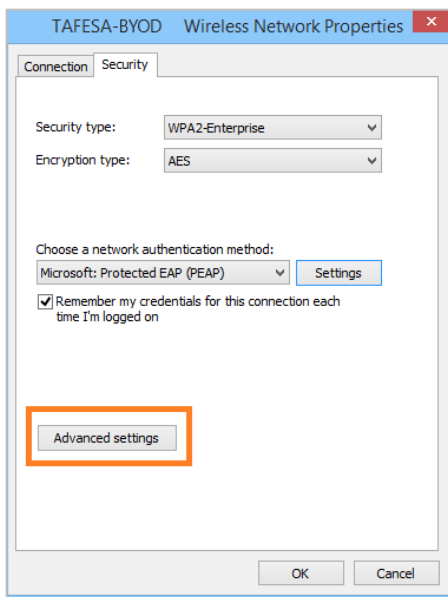
8. Ensure the box next to **Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate** is unticked and click Configure.



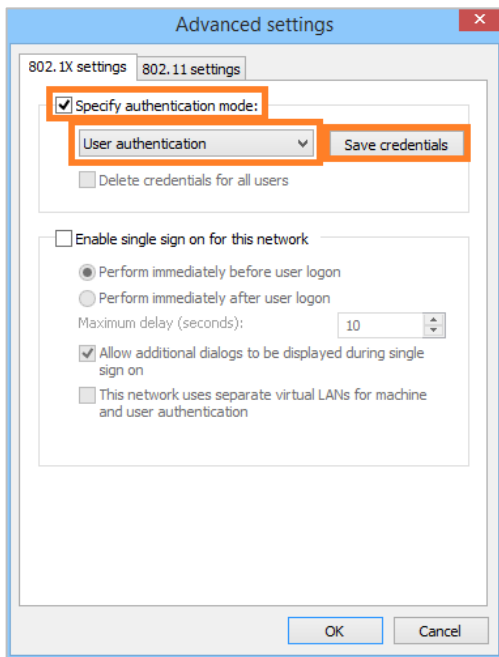
9. Ensure the box next to **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password** is unticked and then click **OK** twice.



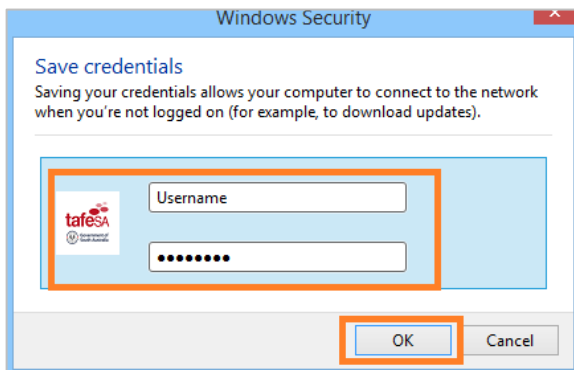
10. Click on the **Advanced settings** button.



11. Tick the box next to **Specify authentication mode** and adjust the drop-down menu to select **User authentication**. Click on **Save credentials**.



12. Enter your TAFE SA username and password where prompted. Click **OK** three times and then click **Close**.



13. You should now be connected to the TAFESA-BYOD Wi-Fi network.
